


# GRINGLEY ON THE HILL PARISH COUNCIL

## Minutes of a Meeting of the Council held in the Village Hall on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2010

- 09/10/244 TO APPROVE APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**  
All members were present.
- 09/10/245 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**  
There were no declarations of interest.
- 09/10/246 TO APPROVE MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE COUNCIL**  
Resolved: That the Minutes of meeting of the Council, held on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2010 be approved as a correct record.
- 09/10/247 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**
- The members discussed the outstanding matters arising list previously circulated by the Clerk and reviewed the jobs that had been completed.
  - Councillor Hilton confirmed that the GP Survey had been completed and forwarded.
  - It was confirmed that the scrap at the rear of the pavilion could be disposed of.

- 09/10/254 PLAYING FIELDS**
- i. The Clerk read out a list of duties undertaken by the handyman.
  - ii. The Clerk reported the outcome of the Wickstead annual inspection of the play equipment. The Clerk undertook to draw up a schedule of work for the wet pour safety surfacing for tender. The Chairman undertook to look at other matters raised.
- 09/10/255 FORMER DETENTION CENTRE SITE**
- The Section 106 agreement is still awaited by Bassetlaw District Council.
  - The hedge cutting had commenced.
- 09/10/256 TO REVIEW THE STANDING ORDERS, FINANCIAL REGULATIONS AND RISK ASSESSMENTS**  
The members reviewed the standing orders, financial regulations and risk assessments and resolved that they were still valid without amendment other than the Clerk was asked to change the word “revised” to “reviewed” at the end of each document.
