**Gringley Wharf**

**Lafarge**

**D**espite extensive opposition by Gringley Parish Council, District Councillors and representatives from neighbouring villages, Lafarge have had their application for the quarry

at Sturton approved by Nottinghamshire County Council. They are expected to move some of the material by barge, but some of it will be taken by lorry along the A631 Gringley bypass en-route to Bawtry.

**Safer Neighbourhoods**

**G**ringley is now part of the safer neighbourhoods group. The group is made up of a beat manager, P.C. Chris Gregson, PCSO Stephanie Jones and representatives from as many organisations as can be encouraged to participate. They meet regularly in different villages in the beat area and discuss the things which are important to you. The key elements highlighted as being of concern to the majority of residents are:
